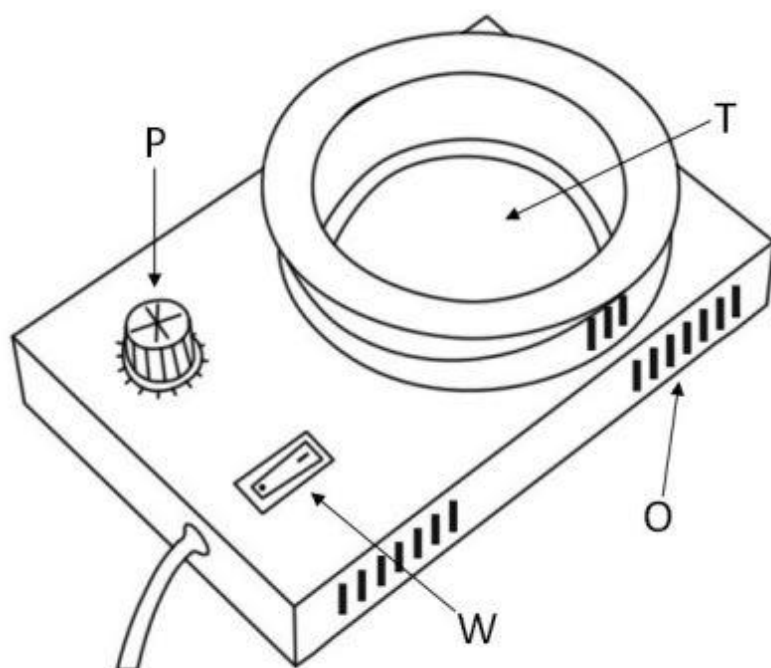
### Quick Start Guide

To protect the environment, we have prepared for you this quick start guide. Before operating the unit, please read it carefully.

### Application

Device for tinning lead ends.

### Unit setup and operation



P- Adjustment knob  
W – Power on switch  
T – Pot  
O – Ventilatioon holes

- Place the device on a stable surface.
- Plug the power cord into the appropriate outlet.
- Place the solder alloy previously cut into small pieces inside the pot respecting the maximum level.
- Turn on the power using the power on switch on the device.
- Set the desired level of temperature and wait until the alloy is melted.
- If oxides float on the surface, they must be removed to preserve the solder clean.



## Precautions

- Do not turn on the unit immediately after moving it from a cold to a warm room. Condensation may damage the device.
- Damaged power cord must be immediately replaced by a qualified technician.
- The device can be used only in well-ventilated areas.
- Do not cover the ventilation holes.
- Never operate the unit with wet hands or when wires are wet as this could cause a short circuit or electric shock.
- Do not place hot device near the flammable objects, liquids, or gases.
- Do not use the station to heat the plastic as it can produce toxic fumes.
- There is a danger of burns by liquid solder.
- Use the proper protective clothing.
- Do not leave the unit unattended.
- The unit should be kept out of reach of children.
- Do not use the soldering pot for purposes other than melting the solder.
- After finishing the work, turn off the power, unplug the power cord and wait for the device to cool down.
- It is forbidden to make any construction modifications to the device. Unauthorized construction modifications will result in loss of warranty and may also cause a malfunction or an accident.
- Never touch the heating element.
- Worn electrical equipment may not be disposed of with other household waste. Worn electrical equipment must be stored in places designated for that.
